Dear Supporter of Restore the Roar,

Thank you for your past support of C.K. McClatchy High School athletics. As you know, playing sports imparts many benefits. Not only does participation in sports provide physical training, but it builds valuable life skills like time management, teamwork, leadership experience, strategies for dealing with adversity, and a mindset for success.

CKM provides opportunities for students to participate in 21 sports, the most in the Sacramento City Unified School District. CKM also has the largest student body in the district with more than 2,400 students, of which one-third play at least one sport throughout the year—that's about 750 student-athletes.

Restore the Roar is the official CKM athletic booster and advocacy club. We are a 501(c)(3) public charity dedicated to supporting the teams and athletes of C.K. McClatchy High School. Restore the Roar supports all athletic programs at CKM to augment needed funding not provided by Sacramento City Unified School District. We are a group of volunteer parents and alumni from diverse backgrounds, representing different sports, who believe that everyone should be offered an equal opportunity to reap the benefits of participating in sports.

We need your support this year. Restore the Roar has been growing in the ways we assist our student-athletes. Here is what your financial donation supports:

- We publicize CKM sporting events and the accomplishments of our talented athletes through live streaming, social media, and press coverage. (Did you see the Lady Lion basketball team this year? They finished the season with two upset wins and an overtime loss in the semi-finals of the Division I CIF State Championship NorCal Tourney. Go Lions!!)
- We offer financial assistance to athletes who qualify for statewide competitions. In recent years, cross country, wrestling, and girls golf have received assistance to compete at the highest state levels.
- We sponsor the annual Senior Night, which honors student-athletes earning a 3.7 grade point average and varsity letter, and gives out additional individual awards, e.g., the Bill Morgan award for sportsmanship and the Woody Adams award for girls' achievement.
- We interview student-athletes and post their stories to the Restore the Roar website (restoretheroar.org).
- We host the Hall of Fame dinner every other year to recognize past CKM Lion achievement and strengthen community.
- We manage the funds for each sporting team, consolidating banking expenses and bookkeeping efforts so that coaches can focus on building up our student-athletes.
- We advocate for District funding to support student-athletes at CKM and other urban, public schools. Recent district improvements at CKM include an all-weather track and field, repaved tennis courts, and updated batting cage.
- We raise funds to support teams with large expenses; for example, we have helped fund track equipment, a new softball fence, swim lane lines, wrestling mats. and cheer megaphones.
